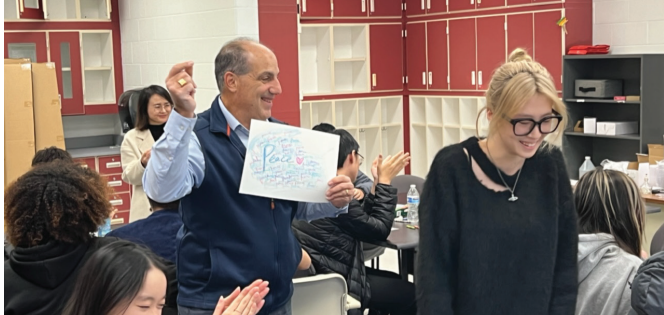


Theme of the Month

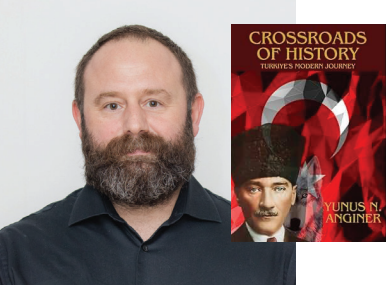
